## PRIVATE PRACTICE RULES AND CONDITIONS

Karts must all travel in the direction shown at or near the Out-Grid entry onto the track,

Only the Track layout shown for Practice can be used – short-cuts, cut throughs and alternative layouts must not be used.

Karts are not permitted to Practice alone. There must always be an adult observing and able to render assistance or contact outside parties in the event of an emergency.

Drivers must hold a current Karting Australia licence that is valid for the class of kart that they are using on Track.

Cadet 9 & Cadet 12 drivers are permitted on the track at the same time.

Junior drivers are not permitted on the Track with any other age division.

Senior drivers are not permitted on the Track with any other age division.

All the apparel requirements of the Karting Australia rulebook must be complied with by all drivers at all times on Track,

No-one is permitted to cross the Track, be inside the Track or be anywhere other than behind barriers whenever karts are on Track.

Each driver and observer should ensure that a suitable First Aid kit is in their possession while at the Circuit.

Each driver should ensure that they have a working mobile phone available while at the Circuit.

It is forbidden to stop on Track for any adjustments, refuelling, tyre checking or pressures or for driver instruction.
