

SCKC – CODE OF CONDUCT

Pit Crew Code of Conduct

- Remember that drivers participate for pleasure and winning is only part of the fun.
- Never ridicule or yell at a young driver for making a mistake or not coming first.
- Be reasonable in your demands on drivers' time, energy and enthusiasm.
- Operate within the rules and spirit of karting and teach your drivers to do the same.
- Avoid overplaying the talented drivers, the just average need and deserve equal time.
- Ensure that equipment and facilities meet safety standards and are appropriate to the age and ability of all drivers.
- Display control, respect and professionalism to all involved with karting. This includes opponents, coaches, officials, administrators, the media, parents and spectators. Encourage drivers to do the same.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.

Administrator's Code of Conduct

- Give all drivers equal opportunities to participate.
- Create pathways for drivers to participate in karting.
- Highlight appropriate behaviour and skill development and help improve the standards of officiating.
- Ensure that everyone involved in karting emphasises fair play, and not winning at all costs.
- Remember that you set an example. Your behaviour and comments should be positive and supportive.
- Make it clear that abusing participants in any way is unacceptable and will result in disciplinary action.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every young person regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
